TECHNICAL

Audience Seating

Total capacity is 7000 and can include a seated reserved section in front of the stage, general admission lawn seating and limited number of covered seats behind the lawn. For a virtual tour of venue please visit the home page of www.boothamphitheatre.com

Looking for an intimate setting? A scaled down intimate seating version of 3,000 seats at the Amphitheatre is also available. This smaller set-up involves 1,000 seats in front of the stage, 378 seat dining and a smaller lawn capacity.

Artist Dressing Rooms

- Star A: Stage left, Restroom with shower in room – 18' x 10'
- Star B: Center stage, Restroom outside room, no shower (suggested production office) – 12' x 14'
- Star C: Stage right, Restroom with shower in room – 10' x 12'
- DSL hard wired wall jack available in dressing room B.
- Chorus Room: Basement of Stage House, Restrooms with men's & women's showers adjacent to dressing room

Staging

- 70' x 45' (70' maximum width at widest point, 45' maximum depth at center stage)
- All wooden stage-No Pyrotechnics, No confetti
- Stage steps down to house
- Crowd control barricade available

Mix Position:

- Mix position – 16' x 16' footprint located 90' from down stage edge – centered.
- Audio & Lighting snake run to front of house is approximately 175' through house cable trough.

Audio Policy: Booth Amphitheatre restricts audio levels at all events to 95 dBA SPL (measured 80' from the stage). Audio levels are measured & monitored in real-time using a Grozier Sound Monitoring Device.

Audio levels are measured in 5-minute averages (95db a LEQ) so that artist sound technicians and venue sound technicians can adjust levels as necessary. These five minute averages are monitored at the mix position in real time.

If the five-minute average exceeds the 95 dBA more than three times, a fine of \$1,000 will be imposed on the artist after the 3rd violation. Beginning with the 4th five-minute sound average exceeding the 95dba limit, a fine of \$1,000 will be applied at settlement. The fine will then double for each violation thereafter; \$1,000 for first violation, \$2,000 for second violation, \$4,000 for the third violation. This applies from the beginning of the event to the end of the event.

Delay Speaker system grid placed inconspicuously amongst the trees provides balanced and articulated sound for large audiences

Rigging

- 24 strong points to rig from
- 2,000 lbs. max per point
- 48,000 lbs total grid max load
- 4 - CM 1 ton Hoists
- 1 Skjonberg 24 way Control System
- **When flying the sound system cabinets we ask that you maintain a bumper trim height of 28 feet off of the deck. This trim height and cabinet focus has proven to help benefit our efforts to keep concert audio from reflecting off of our Crescent Deck roof.**

Height of Rigging Steel: Approx. 48' at DSE (Center) to approximately 42'.6" at upstage edge.

Height of Low Ceiling: Approx. 37'.5" at DSE (Center) to approximately 32' at upstage edge.

Note: Ceiling and rigging steel are not parallel with stage floor

- Two (2) 2k Lycian 1290 mounted on spotlight platforms located approximately 30' DSE at corners, 47'.5" height (45.2 tower bottom to stage)
- Strand Series 300 console, 400 channels
- 8 - Source 4 19 degrees
- 4 - Source 4 26 degrees
- 16 - Source 4 10 degrees hung from Spot towers
- 64 - Source 4 Par hung as a single white stage wash

Electrical

- One 150 Amp, 3 Phase, Sound panel with Camlok Disconnect
- 100' of feeder required from stage to panel
- Two 400 Amp, 3Phase, Camlok Disconnect panels located 100 feet from stage right in basement

Note: 150 Amp system is completely separate from the two 400 Amp systems

Curfew:

- Sunday – 10:00 PM
- Monday through Thursday – 10:00 PM - April 1st through June 10th
- Monday through Thursday – 10:30 PM - June 11th through August 23rd
- Monday through Thursday – 10:00pm – August 24th through October 31st
- Friday and Saturday - 11PM

Catering:

Meals are served in a large dining tent directly behind the stage house next to Symphony Lake. Mobile kitchens are used with a festival type set-up for food preparation and dishwashing.

Truck & Bus Parking:

- Single truck dock at stage (40' flat push to stage)
- One truck can stay at dock. Two trucks can be neatly placed approximately 200' from dock.

- One tour coach can park beside truck dock and one coach approximately 100' from dock.
- Two coaches can be parked approximately 200' from dock. Three 60 amp shore power services available.
