BOOTH AMPHITHEATRE MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

PURPOSE

The 14-member Management Advisory Committee will assist staff in:

- Promoting the Amphitheatre as a viable cultural and entertainment facility for Town of Cary citizens as well as merchants, vendors and performers.
- Provides feedback on the types of events the Amphitheatre may develop – i.e. community festivals, movie night events, town events and celebrations
- Recommends policies regarding Amphitheatre programs including Amphitheatre neighbor program
- Promotes cooperative partnerships and rentals between the Amphitheatre and the Town's business community, neighborhood associations, non-profit groups and cultural community.
- Serves as guest services representatives and other volunteer functions as needed at select events during the event season.

During the Amphitheatre season the committee meets five times annually, on the third Monday of the months of March, May, July, September and November at 6 p.m. at the Amphitheatre.
