VENDOR INFORMATION

SHAKEDOWN STREET ADDRESS:

Koka Booth Amphitheatre 8003 Regency Parkway, Cary, NC 27518.

VENDOR SPACE:

Vendor spaces are available at a fee of \$100 + fees = \$107.38 (online) and \$103.00 (in person at Koka Booth Amphitheatre Box Office) per vendor, per day, which includes two parking spaces.

LOAD IN:

Vendors may load in each day from 1:00PM to 3:00pm only. Vendors who arrive earlier or later than these approved load in times will be turned away. **Refunds will not be given for any reason.**

LOAD OUT:

- Koka Booth Amphitheatre does not own the parking lots. Lots are shared with local businesses, and because of this all vendors must pack up all merchandise, tents etc. each evening by 11:59pm.
- Vendors should allow enough time to load out all items by 12:00am. The venue will not be held responsible for any items left behind. Any unattended items will be disposed of per venue policy.
- Overnight camping or parking is strictly prohibited. Unattended vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

VENDING TIMEFRAME:

Vending will be allowed from 3:00pm-12:00am each day in the approved Shakedown Street lot only.

NO WI-FI OR POWER ACCESS:

Please be aware there is NO access to public Wi-Fi or power in any vendor location in Shakedown Street.

OUTDOOR VENDOR BOOTH SPACES:

Please keep in mind these spaces are outdoors and are exposed to the elements. **We recommend bringing a pop-up tent AND weights for tents.** Pop-Up tents are not required however they are highly recommended as **all events are rain or shine.**

CASHLESS VENUE:

Vendors are permitted to accept cash; however, vendors must be aware that Koka Booth Amphitheatre is a **Cashless venue**. The majority of patrons who enter the venue will most likely carry a limited amount of cash on their persons. We strongly encourage vendors to accept credit cards or other alternative mobile payments (venmo, paypal, cashapp).

PORTA JOHNS:

Porta johns will be located at various spots throughout the parking lots. However, no individuals will have access inside of the restroom facilities inside Koka Booth Amphitheatre until gates officially open. A ticket is required to enter the venue. Re-entry is prohibited.

SHAKEDOWN RULES & REGULATIONS:

- All sales are final. No refunds. No exchanges.
- Upon arrival a staff member will greet all vendors and direct to the available space(s). Spaces will be filled on a first come first served basis each day.
- Vendors may not "hold or save" additional spaces for vendors arriving later in the day.
- Vending is ONLY permitted within the confines of your paid designated space. Vending outside of these spaces is strictly prohibited.
- Trash & Recycle bins will be provided by the venue. Please help us keep the lots & venue clean.
- The following items are <u>NOT ALLOWED</u> to be sold on venue grounds, regardless of location: *illicit substances, weapons, alcohol, food, beverage, and any items requiring grills (gas, charcoal, wood, or electric) or items requiring the use of compressed gas cylinders of any kind.*
- Once parked in the Shakedown Street area, vehicles may not be moved.
- Tents/Canopies are allowed only within the confines of your paid designated vendor space and not within driving lanes.
- Merchandise trading or selling is only allowed within the confines of your paid designated vendor space. Vendors may not "roam," across the parking lot or inside the venue.
- The following items are strictly prohibited anywhere on property. Weapons, illegal substances, loudspeakers, compressed gas cylinders (of any kind), and any other items that the venue considers to be potentially dangerous or disruptive.
- Any violation of these policies will result in forfeiture of your vendor/parking space without a refund. In addition, person(s) may be labeled as "Trespassed" to Koka Booth Amphitheatre and possible subject to local law enforcement.

Please note that all terms and conditions are subject to change without notice. It is your responsibility to review these policies. Your continued use of the parking and vendor space signifies your agreement to these terms and conditions.
